3. Record all electronic and mechanical totals.




Turn Off All Power.

- 4. Turn off all power to dispenser, dispenser lights and STPs. Use system circuit breakers. Multiple disconnects may be required.
- 5. Press CLEAR and then ENTER on the dispenser keypad to turn off the system battery.




- 6. Open main access door.
 - On the A and B sides of the unit, unlock (4) draw latches located behind the right and left option doors.
 - Loosen (4) retaining screws at bottom of main access door using a 3/16" hex Allen wrench.
 - Open main access door to a maximum 90° angle.
- 7. Remove PPU Display by squeezing plastic tab to the right and pulling board straight out. DO NOT DISCARD. Remove (4) Hex Head Screws from corners of Main Display board.

8. Slide out old display filters by gently pulling on tab.

- 9. Install new display filters (R19211-XX) on each Display Board. (See Figure 1.) Filters slide into the front of the LCD Assemblies from the side.
- Snap PPU Display Board into place behind the display mask.
 Mount Main Display Board into place using (4) screws removed in step 7.
- 11. Close main access door.
- 12. Power up unit.
- 13. Check for proper operation.
