ATG Compliance Monitoring, Reporting, & Total Dispatch Management

Also known as:

Enhanced Compliance Management

Platform:

This service is compatible with Emco, Red Jacket ST, Veeder-Root® TLS 200 & 300 series, as well as other tank gauges.

Connectivity:

Compliance may be monitored using various communication options (i.e., Sitefax, GSM, Ethernet and Satellite).

Service Description:

Veeder–Root will remotely poll fueling sites to collect, store and report test results for each tank, line and sensor enrolled in the service. We will engage in remote monitoring, diagnosis, and resolution of non-passing leak detection test results. We will identify, and attempt to resolve problems remotely to deliver valid leak detection (line, tank, and sensor) results reports. If the fuel management analyst is unable to resolve the problem and determines that an on-site visit (aka dispatch) is required, he/she will notify the customer that an authorized ASC will be dispatched to the site.

Veeder-Root Will:

On those occasions when Veeder-Root determines that the designated agent, or contractor must be notified to provide diagnosis and corrective action at a site as a result of a compliance issue, Veeder-Root shall notify the designated agent and contractor by e-mailing such notice at the emailing addresses provided by the customer on the Schedule C. Veeder-Root agrees to notify and dispatch the customer's contractor, if provided, to perform diagnosis and corrective action at a site. The contractor will invoice Veeder-Root for all work associated with the dispatch. Veeder-Root will invoice customer for all charges not covered under any Veeder-Root warranty, plus a 17% service fee. The customer agrees to promptly pay these invoices upon receipt.

Monthly Compliance Reporting

Veeder–Root will remotely poll fueling sites to collect, store and report test results for each tank, line and sensor enrolled in the service. Tanks, Lines, and Sensors will be tested according to Third Party Approved Leak Detection Methods. The customer chooses one method to monitor their lines and one for their tanks. Each month, the test results will be the basis for the Monthly Compliance Report. The monthly compliance report will be available to the customer via FMS online.



Frequency Options

The customer may choose a frequency other than monthly for compliance reporting. The available additional options are:

Weekly: Gilbarco Veeder-Root will poll the sites once a week and report the results weekly in the Compliance Report.

30 Day: Gilbarco Veeder-Root poll sites within 30 days of the last passing result and report the results in the Compliance Report.

User Defined: Customer define time frame (i.e., 28 days) since the last passing test for GVR to poll the site.

Reports:

All reports are available through a secure, password protected web portal (www.fmsonline.com) through which the customer can access reports designed for this service. Available reports include: VR101, VR102 and VR114.
